The journal seeks to provide an online forum for professionals interested in reflecting on the wide range of experiences in the teaching of mathematics at all grade levels, from elementary to graduate. Contributions are welcomed from authors with teaching ideas that advance knowledge and practice in the field of mathematics education.

Manuscripts must be in their final form and prepared in accordance with the instructions provided below. A TeX with or MS Words files should be sent to the Editor-in-Chief. After a paper has been accepted, authors may submit a TeX file of their paper in electronic form.

The authors are cordially invited to submit papers online. Manuscripts submitted to this journal will be considered for publication with the understanding that the same work has not been published and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. The papers submitted to the journal are refereed within 3 months. Upon acceptance the papers are published within 3 months.

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
